Previous to this modification, if the Edit was allowed to continue where the User did not notice this new entry, the man-hours recorded for the task effectively doubled by being duplicated.

The same problem would occur to those entries where the Man-hours are split over number of Tasks when these have been entered via the TimeCard Program. Here, the Begin and End Time records the total man-hours but is averaged and spread over a number of tasks which is impossible to replicate during an Edit process resulting in duplicating the man-hours

With this modification any change in the man-hour column will trigger this advisory caution
