
CHANGING YOUR DESKTOP BACKGROUND COLOR

INTRODUCTION

1. Until recently upgrades to CAFAM64 meant that you could have the Desktop background in any colour as long as it was white.
2. This meant copies of CAFAM running on the same machine all looked the same.
3. We have now found away introduce colour to the Desktop background which this TechNote sets out to explain

EXPLANATION

1. The Program must be first updated to the latest current version
2. Request from us and insert into the CAFAM folder one file called FSCOLOR.DBF
3. This is the colour control file and can be edited for different colours and Window box Caption
4. Open the file called “fscolor.dbf” from Utilities > Repair Files > Repair Data in File



5. Change the numbers in the brackets to suit typed exactly as set out, separated by commas and or the Caption to suit:

Screen	Caption
rgb(255,255,255)	CAFAM PSP - Parts Stockist Program

6. Herewith some useful number combinations and expected colour:
 - (a) rgb(193,255,255) will result in light Blue
 - (b) rgb(120,255,193) will result in light Green
 - (c) rgb(255,255,193) will result in a pale Yellow
 - (d) rgb(255,0,0) will be a strong bright Red
 - (e) rgb(255,150,193) will result in Pink
 - (f) rgb(255,255,255) will be back to plain White
7. When you next launch CAFAM the Desktop Background colour will change as per above
