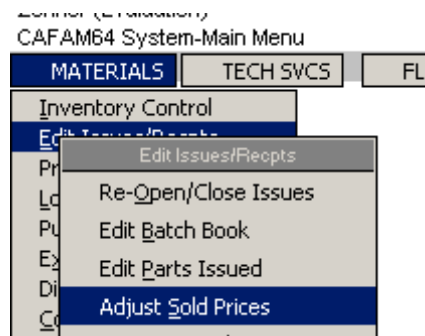


ADJUST SOLD PRICE



This sub-menu has been modified to better control the process of globally adjusting the “Sell Price” on Parts issued. The changes

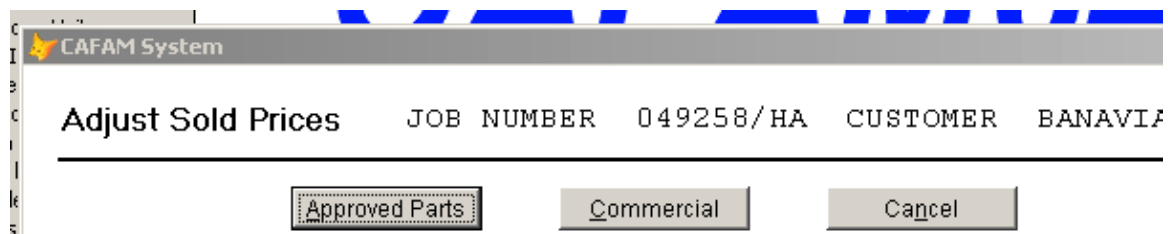
- separates Approved and Commercial Stores
- prompts to exclude or include Part Numbers that have been ‘L’ocked
- has a provision to revert the prices to the original price if so required

As with all the Edits in this section, the Editing process does not check if the Job is Open or Closed. It is down to you to determine this fact and your choice to perform this global adjustment

On selecting a Job



The Program now prompts your for either Approved Stores or Commercial:



On selecting either Approved Stores or Commercial, the next prompt checks whether you want to apply the adjustment too all Sell Prices on the Job or if you wish to exclude those Parts where the price has been 'L'ocked by setting the letter 'L' in the normal Edit screen

Also overwrite 'L'ocked Prices ?

The default is [NO]. Change to [YES] if you want to overwrite all Sell prices irrespective whether they are locked or not.

The next prompt is the % percentage to be applied for the adjustment of the Sell Price

NOTE: Enter 999.99 to revert prices back to original

- (a) Enter a minus amount for discounts e.g. -12.50 for a discount of 12.5%
- (b) Enter the plus amount for markups e.g. 12.50 for a markup of 12.5%
- (c) Enter 999.99 to revert the Sell Price back to the original price

The final prompt is get your confirmation to make the adjustment

In the example above Parts issued to Job No 049258/HA that have not been locked will have their Sell prices marked up by 12.5%

On completing the adjustment the screen will exit with the confirmation "Done: Sell Prices on Job Adjusted"
